

Roots and Fruits

Sick Policy

This policy is designed to protect the health of the children and the staff of Roots and Fruits. The staff reserves the right to refuse your child if he/she displays any of the following symptoms:

- Barking cough
- Unidentifiable rash
- Discolored/unusually heavy nasal discharge
- Temperature
- Water/Crusty/pink eyes
- Vomiting/diarrhea
- Fever
- Symptoms of any unidentifiable/communicable illness

If your child should develop any of these symptoms while in our care you or a relative alternate will be contacted and asked to remove the child immediately. The child may not return to school for 24 hours or until the symptoms have disappeared.

~ Any child who vomits must remain out of school for 24 hours after the last episode of vomiting occurs. Under no circumstances is the child allowed back to school before the 24-hour period is over.

~ Any child who has a fever must remain out of school for 24 hours after the last documented fever.

~ Any child with an unidentifiable or communicable illness may not return to school without the permission of a physician. The staff reserves the right to make this decision.
